In December 2019, Attorney General Gurbir Grewal adopted a comprehensive package of policy initiatives designed to reinforce and clarify the Garden State's commitment to excellence in policing. These statewide policies are intended to promote the culture of professionalism, accountability, and transparency that are hallmarks of New Jersey's best law enforcement agencies. Through Attorney General Grewal's "Excellence in Policing Initiative," the state is building a national model for strengthening trust between law enforcement officers and the communities they serve.

PROFESSIONALISM

- Improving law enforcement training
- Overhauling the state's Police Training Commission
- Promoting officer resiliency
- Identifying early warning signs for at-risk officers

ACCOUNTABILITY

- Ensuring independent investigations of officerinvolved shootings
- Creating a more robust police disciplinary process
- Developing a proposal for police licensure
- Setting minimum standards for Civilian Review Boards

TRANSPARENCY

- Ensuring the public release of police use-offorce footage
- Creating systems for timely disclosure of impeachment material
- Collecting and publishing statewide data on police use-of-force
