Division of Gaming Enforcement Proposes New Rules and Amendments To Strengthen Protections Against Harassment, Discrimination

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES

Date of Proposal: September 21, 2020

Proposal Number: Proposal Number: PRN 2020-088

Proposal Description: New Rules and Amendments in N.J.A.C. 13:69K

Summary of Proposal: The proposed rules will further strengthen equal employment protections in the casino gaming industry. New regulations are proposed that, among other things, would require each casino licensee and casino license applicant to prepare a Plan Prohibiting Harassment and Discrimination (PPHD). Such a plan would address the entity's policies, strategies, procedures, and internal requirements for preventing discrimination or harassment, including sexual harassment.
