

OPERATION PROCEDURES (COVID-19 BEST PRACTICES AND MITIGATION FOR RACING)

Updated 3/31/22

<u>OVERVIEW</u>

- As per Executive Order 242 (paragraph 5 e & f) beginning on Friday, May 28, 2021 Monmouth Park Racetrack and Sports Book will operate with no mask requirement nor social distancing requirement. Individuals who are not fully vaccinated should continue to wear masks in indoor public spaces.
- After 6:00am Friday, May 28, 2021, Monmouth Park Racetrack and Sports Book will operate without any capacity limits in any areas.
- As patrons walk up to the entrance, Patrons will still acknowledge signage regarding Covid symptoms before arriving at the entrance gate. Signage will reflect current best practices on Covid.
- Plastic sneeze guards will still remain in place for racing and sports windows, but will not be a requirement to operate a window or ticket writer.
- Patrons will be required to lower their mask when conducting cashier transactions and when requested for identification purposes
- Per Executive Order 242, all dining areas will operate normally at full capacity with no spacing limitations.
- Cleaning will continue to commence diligently throughout the facility as it was pre-covid, especially in high-traffic locations.
 - o Should a Covid positive arise, that specific area will be Covid-sanitized thoroughly.
- Employees testing positive for covid will inform their supervisors and quarantine for the CDC-recommended amount of days before returning to work. Positives will be reported

to the local health department through our track physician (in accordance to Director's DGE March 25,2022 email)

- Monmouth employees will not be required to wear a mask during work hours in public spaces, however unvaccinated individuals should continue to wear masks indoors.
