ORDER

The Division filed a complaint on September 7, 2011, Docket No. 11-1338-VC, seeking sanctions against TROPICANA ATLANTIC CITY CORP. d/b/a TROPICANA CASINO and RESORT ("Tropicana") alleging violations of the rules of the game in that Tropicana failed to remove all cards having a value of "10" from the decks to be used in the game of Spanish 21; and,


Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq., specifically N.J.S.A. 5:12-100(e)(a) and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically N.J.A.C. 19:47-1.19-3(b); and;

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and

finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby ORDER that the settlement be adopted and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000 be imposed upon Tropicana, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
