ORDER


The Division, filed a Complaint on September 28, 2011, Docket No. 11-1384-VC, seeking sanctions against Tropicana for reasons set forth therein and, more specifically that Tropicana permitted an underage individual to enter and remain within the licensed casino premises and to engage in wagering activity; and,

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq., specifically N.J.S.A. 5:12-119(b) and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically N.J.A.C. 19:43-16.1(a); and;

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby ORDER that the settlement be adopted and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$17,500 be imposed upon Tropicana, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division..
