ORDER

The Division filed a complaint on January 27, 2014, Docket No. 14-0043-VC, seeking sanctions against MARINA DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, LLC d/b/a BORGATA HOTEL, CASINO & SPA ("BORGATA") for reasons set forth therein and, more specifically that BORGATA permitted an underaged individual to engage in wagering activity and consume an alcoholic beverage on the casino floor; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq., specifically N.J.S.A. 5:12-71.2 and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically N.J.A.C. 13:69G-2.4; and

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby ORDER that the settlement be adopted and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$7,000 be imposed upon MARINA DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, LLC d/b/a BORGATA HOTEL, CASINO & SPA, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
