The Division filed a complaint on October 6, 2014, Docket No. 14-0611-VC, seeking sanctions against CAESARS INTERACTIVE ENTERTAINMENT NEW JERSEY, LLC, ("CIENJ") for reasons set forth therein and, more specifically that CIENJ caused promotional materials to be e-mailed to persons who were either Internet self-excluded or were on the self-exclusion list; and


Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq., and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically, N.J.A.C. 13:69G-2.4(a) and (b); and

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and

finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby **ORDER** that the settlement be adopted and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000 be imposed upon CIENJ, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
