ORDER

The Division filed a complaint on June 24, 2015, Docket No. 15-0212-VC, seeking sanctions against MARINA DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, LLC d/b/a BORGATA HOTEL, CASINO & SPA ("BORGATA"), for reasons set forth therein and, more specifically that BORGATA:

- I. on September 22, 2014, through its personnel, allowed two underage individuals to be served and to consume alcoholic beverages;
- II. on January 11, 2015, through its personnel, allowed an underage individual to enter the casino, remain in the casino, and wager at games in the casino;
- III. on February 13, 2015, through its personnel, allowed an underage individual to enter the casino, remain in the casino, wager at games in the casino, and receive complimentary services or items as a result of, or in anticipation of, that

individual's gaming activity, and permitted the service of an alcoholic beverage to that underage individual; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq., and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically N.J.A.C. 13:69I-1.2(a) and by incorporation thereof, N.J.A.C. 13:2-23.1(a); N.J.A.C. 13:69C-16.1(a)1, N.J.A.C. 13:69C-16.1(a)2, N.J.A.C. 13:69C-16.1(a)3 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-16.1(a)5; and

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby **ORDER** that the settlement be adopted and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$27,500 be imposed upon BORGATA, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
