LETTER ORDER
REVOKING VENDOR REGISTRATION

RE: Prohibition of business transactions between New Jersey casino applicants or licensees, their employees or agents and Poker Pro Labs and Len Mugin, Peter Kiritchenko, and Alex Kotlyar (Vendor No. 88235)

ORDER NO. 1350

Dear Mr. Mugin:

On May 18, 2015, Harrah's Resort Atlantic City filed a Vendor Registration Form on behalf of Poker Pro Labs, a data analyst for online gaming operators, listing yourself, Peter Kiritchenko, and Alex Kotlyar, as the entity's qualifiers. By letter dated June 8, 2015, the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division") notified Poker Pro Labs that it had 30 days within which to file a Vendor Registration Supplemental Disclosure Form ("VRSDF"). On August 20, 2015, by electronic mail and certified mail, return receipt requested, the Division notified Poker Pro Labs that it had seven days within which to file a VRSDF. Additionally, a copy of this August 20, 2015 notification was provided to Harrah's by electronic and regular mail.

When the August 20, 2015 notification was returned to the Division marked "Unclaimed," the Division notified Poker Pro Labs and Harrah's by November 2, 2015 electronic mail that Poker Pro Labs had until the close of business on Friday, November 6, 2015, to file its VRSDF. That extended deadline has passed, and Poker Pro Labs has not filed its VRSDF.


Neither you, Mr. Kiritchenko, Mr. Kotlyar, nor Poker Pro Labs are affiliated with any other vendor registrants or maintain any other license or registration under the New Jersey Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq.*

As a result of Poker Pro Labs' failure to file a VRSDF as required by *N.J.A.C. 13:69A-5.11(c)*, it is hereby ordered, as of this date, that Poker Pro Labs, Peter Kiritchenko, Alex Kotlyar and you, Len Mugin, are prohibited from conducting any direct or indirect business with any casino applicant or licensee (hereafter, casino) or any person acting on behalf of a casino, pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 13:69A-5.11(d)*.

Further, in accordance with *N.J.A.C. 13:69A-5.11(d)*, any casino or person acting on behalf of a casino is prohibited from conducting direct or indirect business with Poker Pro Labs, and Peter Kiritchenko, Alex Kotlyar and you, Len Mugin.

Finally, any existing agreements, whether written or unwritten, between Poker Pro Labs, and Peter Kiritchenko, Alex Kotlyar and you, Len Mugin, and any casino or person acting on behalf of a casino must be terminated immediately, pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 13:69C-10.1(c)2*.
