**ORDER**

The Division filed a complaint on May 4, 2016, Docket No. 16-0215-VC, seeking sanctions against Marina District Development Company, LLC d/b/a Borgata Hotel, Casino & Spa (“Borgata”) for reasons set forth therein and, more specifically, that Borgata failed to identify a self-excluded person and permitted a self-excluded person to engage in wagering activity; and,

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq.*, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically *N.J.S.A. 5:12-71.2(a)* and *N.J.A.C. 13:69G-2.4(a)1, 2 and 3*; and,

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and

finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby **ORDER** that the civil penalty in the amount of \$7,500 as agreed to by the parties in the Stipulation of Settlement be imposed upon Borgata, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
