The Division filed a complaint on April 6 2017, Docket No. 17-0115-VC, seeking sanctions against HARRAH'S ATLANTIC CITY OPERATING COMPANY, LLC, d/b/a HARRAH'S RESORT ATLANTIC CITY ("Harrah's") for reasons set forth therein and, more specifically that Harrah's permitted an underage individual to enter and remain within the licensed casino premises; and failed to detect that the individual was underage after the individual presented proper identification displaying her accurate age, which allowed the underage individual to engage in wagering activity, to wit, wagering at blackjack and, further, that Harrah's failed to remove the underage individual from the premises pursuant to Section IV, paragraph 5 of Harrah's' internal controls, which resulted in the underage individual engaging in additional wagering activity on slot machines; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 *et seq.*, specifically N.J.S.A. 5:12-119(b), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically, N.J.A.C. 13:69C-16.1(a)2 and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-16.1(a)3; as well as N.J.A.C. 13:69D-1.3(b) and Section IV, Paragraph 5 of Harrah's' Internal Controls; and


Having considered any discipline imposed by Harrah's upon any employees directly involved in the violations; and

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby **ORDER** that the settlement be adopted and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$9,000.00 be imposed upon Harrah's, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
