ORDER

The Division filed a complaint on January, 25, 2018, Docket No. 18-0039-VC, seeking sanctions against Marina District Development Company, LLC d/b/a Borgata Hotel, Casino & Spa (“Borgata”) for reasons set forth therein and, more specifically, that Borgata permitted three (3) underage persons to enter its licensed facility and engage in wagering activity; and

Borgata acknowledges that subsequent to the filing of the complaint, on three (3) additional occasions underage individuals entered its licensed facility and engaged in wagering activity; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A.*

5:12-1 et seq., and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically N.J.S.A. 5:12-71(a) and N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.7(a); and

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby **ORDER** that the civil penalty in the amount of \$15,000 as agreed to by the parties in the Stipulation of Settlement be imposed upon Borgata, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
