Dear Mr. Pingel:

In accordance with *N.J.A.C. 13:69J-1.14A* and *1.14B*, Richard Pingel, Chief Legal Officer and Secretary of Sportech Racing, LLC, a casino service industry enterprise, filed the appropriate qualifier forms and was designated a pendent qualifier of the entity. As set forth by regulation, a pendent qualifier is required to establish his plenary qualification within 18 months.

The Division has investigated Mr. Pingel's suitability for qualification and finds that he has established his financial stability, integrity and responsibility, as well as his good character, honesty and integrity, as is required by *N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(1)* and (2), incorporated by reference in *N.J.S.A. 5:12-92b*, and should therefore be deemed to have established his plenary qualification in connection with the casino service industry enterprise licensee.


