Civil Action
ORDER 1861

The Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division"), being authorized by *N.J.A.C.* 13:69B-2.9 to impose civil monetary penalties up to \$2,000 upon licensees for regulatory violations; and

The Division having sent a Notice of Violation to Gaming Innovation Group ("GiG") on February 26, 2019 imposing a \$2,000 civil penalty for allowing patron registrations to be completed without social security numbers; and

GiG having agreed to the proposed penalty on March 11, 2019; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-1 *et seq.*, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically for violations of *N.J.A.C.* 13:69D-2.2(d); -2.3(d); -2.3(g); 13:69O-1.3(b)1iii, -1.3(b)5; -1.4(c)2; and -1.4(j)1;

I hereby **ORDER** that the civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000 as agreed to by the parties be imposed upon GiG, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
