ORDER

WHEREAS, 1000 Boardwalk, LLC d/b/a Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Atlantic City ("HRAC") holds a casino license and is authorized to conduct Internet gaming through an Internet Gaming Permit issued by the Division; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2020, the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division") filed a complaint ("Complaint") seeking the forfeiture of \$620.11 in Internet gaming monies which were won by patrons under the age of twenty-one, to wit: AM, MS, DS, and LL ("Underage Patrons") pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-71.3c; and

WHEREAS, the Complaint was served upon HRAC, together with notice of the

Underage Patrons' right to demand a plenary hearing within fifteen days pursuant to

N.J.S.A. 5:12-71.3; and

WHEREAS, Counsel for HRAC interposed no objection to the entry of a forfeiture

order; and

WHEREAS, none of the Underage Patrons demanded a plenary hearing within

the requisite time period, thereby waiving their rights to a hearing and constructively

admitting the allegations in the Complaint pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71.3; and

WHEREAS, the Division considered the entire record in this matter;

IT IS ORDERED that the amount of \$620.11 in gaming monies won by Underage

Patrons, as indicated above, is hereby forfeited pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71.3; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of an invoice from the Division,

HRAC is directed to remit the forfeited money to the Division for appropriate disposition

in accordance with the terms of N.J.S.A. 5:12-71.3c.
