ORDER

On September 4, 2019, the Division filed a complaint under Docket Number 19-0746-VC seeking sanctions against William Hill New Jersey, Inc., for the reasons set forth more fully therein. More specifically, despite the Division's November 5, 2018 email, on March 17, 2019 and March 19, 2019, William Hill permitted wagering on two NCAA basketball games;

On March 17, 2019, William Hill permitted wagering on Prairie View A&M versus Farleigh Dickinson and Wofford versus Seton Hall. William Hill accepted three wagers;

On March 19, 2019, William Hill permitted wagering on Prairie View A&M versus Farleigh Dickinson. No wagers were accepted;

William Hill acknowledged that both incidents were in violation of N.J.S.A. 13:69N-1.1;

William Hill voided all wagers and refunded the patrons prior to the beginning of the stated events;

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement executed by the parties, I find sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty.

I hereby **ORDER** that the \$5,000 civil penalty agreed to by the parties in the Stipulation of Settlement be imposed upon William Hill.
