IN THE MATTER OF RUSH STREET
INTERACTIVE

Civil Action

ORDER

The Division of Gaming Enforcement (“Division”), being authorized by *N.J.A.C.* 13:69B-2.9 to impose civil monetary penalties up to \$2,000 upon licensees for regulatory violations; and

The Division having sent a Notice of Violation to Rush Street Interactive on June 28, 2021, imposing a \$1,000 civil penalty for accepting wagers on pre-game Sports Market after the sporting event had concluded, the failure to suspend the market, and the voiding of the accepted wagers without the Division’s approval, in violation of *N.J.A.C.* 13:69N-1.9(j) and (n) and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69N-1.11(d); and

Rush Street Interactive having agreed to the proposed penalty on July 29, 2021; and

Rush Street Interactive having noted the following additional information:

On May 13, 2021, Kambi notified the Rush Street Interactive Sports Team of the error. On May 18, 2021, Rush Street Interactive’s Director of Technical Compliance, Nikul Patel, was notified of the issue via email. On May 26, 2021, Kambi’s Senior Vice President of Compliance, Oliver Lamb, advised the Division that the pre-game market

was created manually because it was a special offering specific to a particular soccer game. He advised the Division that on May 13, 2021, Kambi's Sports Trader, Dean Daily, located in United Kingdom, manually entered the incorrect start date as May 14, 2021, allowing the past post wagering.

Rush Street Interactive has advised that to prevent this issue moving forward, Kambi's Compliance Team has implemented mandatory additional Quality Assurance training for the Trading Team. Rush Street Interactive having advised that Kambi's Trading Team is now required to obtain secondary approval from supervisors for all manual entries on the sports data feed.

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq.*, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically for a violation of *N.J.A.C. 13:69N-1.9(j)* and (n) and *N.J.A.C. 13:69N-1.11(d)*; and having considered the additional information submitted by Rush Street, as set forth above;

I hereby **ORDER** that the civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000 as agreed to by the parties be imposed upon Rush Street Interactive, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
