JOINT PETITION OF RESORTS DIGITAL GAMING, LLC, PLAY'N GO NEW JERSEY LLC AND TSG Re: INTERACTIVE US SERVICES LIMITED TO CONDUCT INTERNET GAMING RELATED BUSINESS PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 5:12-92a(1) (PRN 2582102)

Dear Nicholas Moles, Marie Jones and Jeremy Kleiman:

The Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division") has completed its review of PRN 2582102, which seeks authorization to conduct internet gaming related business transactions between Resorts Digital Gaming, LLC, Play'N Go New Jersey LLC and TSG Interactive US Services Limited, the latter two of which are applicants for casino service industry enterprise ("CSIE") licensure, pursuant to an August 12, 2021 U.S. Casino Software License and Services Agreement, which was previously submitted to the Division.

Therefore, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-92a(1) and N.J.A.C. 13:69J-1.2B, and for good cause shown, internet gaming related business transactions between the petitioners are deemed to be approved for a term to expire six months from the date of this Order, subject to the continued approval of all product submissions by the Division's Technical Service Bureau as authorized by the issuance of an Approval Letter by the Director and subject further to the representations contained within the joint petition. This approval is further subject to each new product submission's approval as required by the Division's Technical Service Bureau. It is further provided that any new business transacted pursuant to this approval be reported to the Division within the time frames set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:69J-1.2B(a)1iv. Further, petitioners must maintain and make available for inspection, upon demand by the Division, any records regarding the business transacted. Moreover, any changes to the current agreement must be reported to the Division within five (5) business days. The Division may reconsider the granting of this approval at any time.
