Civil Action

ORDER

The Division of Gaming Enforcement (“Division”), being authorized by *N.J.A.C.* 13:69B-2.9 to impose civil monetary penalties up to \$2,000 upon licensees for regulatory violations; and

The Division having sent a Notice of Violation to Caesars Sportsbook on October 20, 2022, imposing a \$500 civil penalty for the improper programming of their system to reflect the published House Rules and the failure to follow those published House Rules, in violation of Division requirements *N.J.A.C.* 13:69D-2.3(c) and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69N-1.7(g)(1); and

The Division having required that the patron involved be properly compensated in this matter; and

Caesars Sportsbook having agreed to the proposed penalty and compensation to the patron on October 24, 2022; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-1 *et seq.*, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically for a violation of *N.J.A.C.* 13:69D-2.3(c) and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69N-1.7(g)(1);

I hereby **ORDER** that the civil penalty in the amount of \$500 as agreed to by the parties be imposed upon Caesars Sportsbook, payable upon receipt of an invoice from

the Division. Additionally, Caesars Sportsbook is required to submit proof that the patron has been properly compensated.
