Petition of Evolution New Jersey LLC
To Allow Celebrity Guest(s) at the
Live Dealer Studios

ORDER
PRN 0392302

By its Petition, PRN 0392302 to the Division of Gaming Enforcement (“Division”), Evolution New Jersey, LLC (“Evolution”), requests permission to allow in person Celebrity Guest(s) at both of its Live Dealer Studios located at Boardwalk 1000, LLC d/b/a Hard Rock Hotel and Casino Atlantic City and A.C. Ocean Walk, LLC d/b/a Ocean Resort Casino. Evolution has represented to the Division that its Celebrity Guest will interact with players and Evolution’s Game Presenter or Host during live game play both verbally and via chat. Evolution has also represented that the Celebrity Guest will not interact with gaming equipment or Dealers’ Modules.

The Petition has also represented that the Celebrity Guest is prohibited from delaying or intervening in game flow and/or game outcomes. The Petition has also stated that when the Celebrity Guest is on the Gaming Floor, they will be supervised by Evolution personnel.

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq.*; and

Having also considered the relevant provisions of *N.J.A.C. 13:69O-1.4*;

It is hereby **ORDERED** that the Petition be granted; and

This approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. Evolution will conduct all Live Dealer games that have a Celebrity Guest in accordance with the descriptions and representations included in PRN 0392302 and its Internal Control submitted on or about September 28, 2023.

2. At no time shall a Celebrity Guest be unsupervised on the Gaming Floor, MCR Room, or Equipment Room. The Division has determined that the appropriate Evolution personnel to supervise the Celebrity Guest in these designated areas are members of Evolution's Management Team as identified in PRN 0392302 and its Internal Controls submitted on or about September 28, 2023; i.e. Team Manager, Floor Supervisor, or above.
3. The Division reserves the right to revoke the approval granted in Condition Number 2 and require a Key Employee to supervise the Celebrity Guest at its Discretion.
4. Surveillance shall be notified prior to the Celebrity Guest entering the Gaming Floor, MCR Room or Equipment Room. The Celebrity Guest's access to these restricted areas shall be documented in a bound ledger/logbook. This ledger/logbook shall be maintained on premises and be made available for inspection by the Division upon request.
5. The Celebrity Guest shall not interfere with any gaming equipment. This includes but is not limited to, cards, roulette balls, card shoes, crap sticks, shuffler machines, and dice.
6. The Celebrity Guest may not interact with the Dealer's Module.
7. The Celebrity Guest shall not delay or otherwise affect game flow.
8. It is Evolution's responsibility to ensure proper game play when the Celebrity Guest is present.
9. It is Evolution's responsibility to ensure compliance with its Internal Controls when the Celebrity Guest is present.
10. It is Evolution's responsibility to ensure compliance with all Division Regulations and the Casino Control Act when the Celebrity Guest is present.
11. If at any time Evolution violates any of these enumerated Conditions, the Division reserves the right to revoke this authorization.
