ORDER

The Division of Gaming Enforcement (“Division”), being responsible pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-76* for enforcement of the Casino Control Act and its accompanying regulations; and

The Division having sent a letter in lieu of Complaint to BetMGM, then known as Roar Digital (“Roar”), on May 15, 2020, alleging that Roar had allowed a self-excluded patron to create an account and play, in violation of *N.J.A.C. 13:69G-2.4(a)2*; and

The Division having waived any civil penalties for said violation but having demanded disgorgement by Roar of any monies won from the self-excluded patron, specifically \$8,880.00; and

Roar having agreed to the proposed disgorgement; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq.*, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically for violations of *N.J.A.C. 13:69G-2.4(a)2*;

I hereby **ORDER** that Roar remit \$8,880.00 payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division.
