The Division of Gaming Enforcement (“Division”) filed a complaint on or about January 31, 2024, under Docket Number 24-0107-VC that sought sanctions against William Hill New Jersey Inc. d/b/a William Hill Sportsbook (“William Hill”), for reasons set forth therein and more specifically regarding conduct from February 2022 until April 2023 in which William Hill had permitted wagering on sporting events after the outcomes of the events were already known; and

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1, et seq.*, the Sports Wagering Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12A-1, et seq.*, and the regulations, specifically *N.J.A.C. 13:69D-2.3(c)*, *N.J.A.C. 13:69N-1.9(j)*, and *N.J.A.C. 13:69N-1.9(n)*; and

Having considered the remedial action taken by William Hill in response to these violations; and

Having considered the Stipulation of Settlement which the parties executed and finding sufficient legal and factual support for the recommended penalty therein.

I hereby **ORDER** that the settlement be adopted and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$20,000.00 be imposed upon William Hill, payable upon receipt of an invoice from the Division’s Revenue Unit.
