COMPLAINT TO SEMINOLE HARD ROCK
DIGITAL

ORDER # 2852

It is hereby **ORDERED** that the Action in Lieu of Complaint dated August 26, 2025 and issued by the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division") to Seminole Hard Rock Digital ("SHRD") regarding the transaction of business with a casino service industry enterprise ("CSIE") license applicant, while SHRD itself also was a CSIE license applicant, without first having obtained a transactional waiver in violation of *N.J.S.A. 5:12-92a(1)*, *N.J.A.C. 13:69C-10.1* through *10.4*, and *N.J.A.C. 13:69J-1.2B(a)1* is hereby adopted;

It is further **ORDERED** that the Division imposes a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000 upon SHRD, which penalty has been accepted by SHRD. This amount shall be payable, in full, by SHRD, upon the receipt of a billing invoice from the Division.
