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RE: JOINT PETITION OF WAZDAN NJ LLC TO CONTINUE TO CONDUCT INTERNET GAMING RELATED BUSINESS PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 5:12-92a(1) (PRN 0542604)

Dear Jeremy Kleiman:

The Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division") has completed its review of PRN 0542604, which seeks authorization to renew PRN 2202502, for Wazdan NJ LLC, an applicant for casino service industry enterprise ("CSIE") licensure, to continue to conduct internet gaming related business transactions with the following:

1. AC Ocean Walk LLC d/b/a Ocean Casino Resort, LNW Gaming, Inc., a CSIE licensee, and Playstar NJ, LLC, an applicant for CSIE licensure, pursuant to an agreement that was previously provided to the Division.
2. Boardwalk 1000, LLC d/b/a Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Atlantic City, HR Atlantic City, LLC, LNW Gaming, Inc., and Hillside (New Jersey), LLC d/b/a Bet365, the latter two of which are CSIE licensees, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.
3. Boardwalk 1000, LLC d/b/a Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Atlantic City, HR Atlantic City, LLC, LNW Gaming, Inc., a CSIE licensee, and Seminole Hard Rock Digital, LLC, an applicant for CSIE licensure, pursuant to an agreement that was previously provided to the Division.
4. DGMB Casino, LLC d/b/a Resorts Casino Hotel, Boyd Digital Gaming, LLC f/k/a Resorts Digital Gaming, LLC, an applicant for CSIE licensure, and LNW Gaming, Inc., a CSIE licensee, pursuant to an agreement that was previously provided to the Division.
5. DGMB Casino, LLC d/b/a Resorts Casino Hotel, LNW Gaming, Inc., and Crown NJ Gaming, Inc. d/b/a DraftKings, the latter two of which are CSIE licensees, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.
6. DGMB Casino, LLC d/b/a Resorts Casino Hotel, Penn Sports Interactive, LLC, and LNW Gaming, Inc., the latter two of which are CSIE licensees, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.



7. Golden Nugget Atlantic City, LLC, Golden Nugget Online Gaming, LLC, and LNW Gaming, Inc., the latter two of which are CSIE licensees, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.
8. Golden Nugget Atlantic City, LLC and Rush Street Interactive NJ, LLC, a CSIE licensee, pursuant to an agreement that was previously provided to the Division.
9. Marina District Development Company, LLC d/b/a Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa, Boyd Interactive USA, LLC f/k/a Pala Interactive, LLC, an applicant for CSIE licensure, and LNW Gaming, Inc., a CSIE licensee, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.
10. Marina District Development Company, LLC d/b/a Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa, bwin.party (USA), Inc., BetMGM, LLC, and LNW Gaming, Inc., the latter three of which are CSIE licensees, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.
11. Premier Entertainment AC, LLC d/b/a Bally's Atlantic City, FBG Enterprises Opco, LLC d/b/a Fanatics, an applicant for CSIE licensure, and LNW Gaming, Inc., a CSIE licensee, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.
12. Tropicana Atlantic City Corp. d/b/a Tropicana Atlantic City, Caesars Interactive Entertainment New Jersey, LLC, William Hill New Jersey, LLC, and LNW Gaming, Inc., the latter two of which are CSIE licensees, pursuant to agreements that were previously provided to the Division.

Therefore, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-92a(1)* and *N.J.A.C. 13:69J-1.2B*, and for good cause shown, internet gaming related business transactions between the petitioners are deemed to be approved **for a term to expire on September 4, 2026, subject to the continued approval of all product submissions by the Division's Technical Services Bureau as authorized by the issuance of an Approval Letter by the Director and subject further to the representations contained within the joint petition. This approval is further subject to each new product submission's approval as required by the Division's Technical Services Bureau.** It is further provided that any new business transacted pursuant to this approval be reported to the Division within the time frames set forth in *N.J.A.C. 13:69J-1.2B(a)1iv*. Further, petitioners must maintain and make available for inspection, upon demand by the Division, any records regarding the business transacted. **Moreover, any changes to the current agreements must be reported to the Division within five (5) business days.** The Division may reconsider the granting of this approval at any time.
