
IN THE MATTER OF A NOTICE OF
VIOLATION TO FBG ENTERPRISES
OPCO, LLC D/B/A FANATICS

WHEREAS, on or about January 9, 2026, the Division of Gaming Enforcement (“Division”) served upon FBG Enterprises Opco, LLC d/b/a Fanatics (“Fanatics”) a Notice of Violation, pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 13:69B-2.9*;

WHEREAS, the Division, via the above-mentioned Notice of Violation, determined that Fanatics shall be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000 to address the regulatory violation pertaining to Fanatics’ failure to comply with *N.J.A.C. 13:69G-2.4(b)(1)*;

WHEREAS, on or about January 20, 2026, Fanatics acknowledged the violation and agreed with the Division’s civil penalty determination in the amount of \$2,000;

Having considered the relevant provisions of the Casino Control Act, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-1 et seq.*, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, specifically *N.J.A.C. 13:69B-2.9 et seq.*

I HEREBY ORDER approval of the Notice of Violation and impose a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000 upon Fanatics. This amount shall be payable, in full, by Fanatics, upon the receipt of a billing invoice from the Division.
