**Additional Information**

On December 10, 1981, while at Harrah's Marina Hotel Casino, Christopher Gilmartin was observed capping and skimming his bets at the game of blackjack. On February 23, 1983, Mr. Gilmartin entered a plea of guilty to cheating and swindling at the game of blackjack, contrary to N.J.S.A. 5:12-113(b). In Atlantic City Municipal Court, Judge Consalvo imposed a \$50 fine and ordered Mr. Gilmartin to pay court costs of \$25. Gilmartin also paid \$25 to the Violent Crimes Commission.
