On September 5, 1979, Leon Louis Hammer was arrested for Impersonating a Public Servant, a Casino Control Commission Inspector. Specifically, while at the Caesar's Boardwalk Regency Casino, Mr. Hammer presented himself to a security officer of the Boardwalk and attemped to gain an access badge for the casino. He advised the Security Officer that he was working for the Commission.
