**Additional Information**

Daniel J. Marino withdrew his initial objection to being placed on the exclusion list. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71(f) and N.J.A.C. 19:42-4.4(d), for the purpose of considering placement of his name on the exclusion list, he was found by the Commission to have constructively admitted all matters and facts in the Division's petition. The allegations in the Division's petition demonstrated, by a preponderance of the evidence, that Marino should be placed on the exclusion list pursuant to section 71 of the Act and N.J.A.C. 19:48-1.3a. Specifically, the petition alleged that: Marino was a "soldier" in the Gambino organized crime family in NYC; that he associated with one or more additional members of the Gambino family; and that he had two criminal convictions punishable with more than six months in prison.
