On April 10, 2008, Douglas Rubino was indicted for knowingly promoting the commission of the crimes of money laundering, criminal usury and promoting gambling involving a sports-betting operation at the Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa. On December 19, 2008, Douglas Rubino pleaded guilty to N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, conspiracy, and on March 6, 2009, he was sentenced to ninety (90) days incarceration in the Atlantic County Jail and three (3) years probation. Mr. Rubino was ordered to stay out of Atlantic City casinos during his probation period.
