REIMBURSEMENT RATE

The Reimbursement Rate is set by the Division of Highway Traffic Safety at \$60.00 per hour. If a municipality submits a Reimbursement Form with an hourly rate higher than \$60.00, <u>ABC will</u> only reimburse up to \$60.00 per hour.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. QUALIFYING LETTER REQUESTING FUNDING TO RUN THE PROGRAM

<u>Summer Shore Initiative 2024:</u> (1) Describing the municipality as a summer shore community, or as a gateway to a shore community; (2) detailing that during the summer months, a noticeable influx of individuals under the age of 21 are found in the municipality; and (3) the names and addresses of plenary retail distribution licensees that will be cooperating with the police department to run the program.

2. APPLICANT INFORMATION

- 3. APPLICATION AUTHORIZATION Must be signed by an authorized official (Mayor, Administrator, Clerk, CFO, etc.) NOT the Chief or primary contact for the municipality's grant.
