Federal Fiscal Year 2023 (FFY23) STOP Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Grant

Program, County Prosecutors' Offices Victim Services Grants

Take notice that, in compliance with N.J.S.A. 52:14-34.4, the Department of Law & Public

Safety, Office of the Attorney General (Department), announces the anticipated availability and

award of \$987,259 in funding to support victim services in the County Prosecutors' Offices of

Victim Witness Advocacy under the FFY23 STOP Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)

Grant Program. Each County Prosecutor's office will receive formula based funding. Funding

was allocated by the percentage of indictments, accusations for 2021; charges posted to Justice

Data for indictable crimes for unique defendants for 2022; and new victims served in each county

prosecutor's office during 2021 and 2022. Funding is provided on a reimbursement basis only

and is contingent upon subrecipient application submissions, compliance with grant conditions,

and satisfactory performance of services. Funding can be used to develop and strengthen

investigation and prosecution of cases involving domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking

and/or dating violence. The funding allocation is for a 12-month project period of July 1, 2024

to June 30, 2025. Extensions of the project period will not be granted.

Eligible applicants will receive application packages from the Office of the Attorney General, notifying the agency of the award. Notifications will be emailed no later than February 29, 2024. The application <u>must</u> be returned within 60 days of the date on the application letter. **Project** narratives will be limited to ten (10) pages in total. The application must be returned by email to <u>vawa@njoag.gov</u>.

Under this notice, the Federal grant period is from July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2025. Eligible recipients of the non-competitive FFY23 VAWA program funds will receive application guidelines and all required application forms, via e-mail, that must be completed and submitted by the established due date. An applicant that is designated as a high-risk grantee by L&PS is to submit a separate attachment to its application, information that L&PS will use, among other pertinent information, to determine whether it will consider or select the application for an award under this solicitation. The file should be named "L&PS High-Risk Grantee Applicant Disclosure and Justification". Upon approval of project narrative and budget, applicants will receive subaward contract documents for approval and signature. Subrecipients must comply with programmatic and fiscal reporting requirements for approval and/or reimbursement of costs incurred during the project period. All subrecipients will be required to supply matching funds of twenty-five percent towards their project.

Please note that funding allocations and individual subaward amounts are subject to change. Subrecipients shall recognize and agree that both the initial provision of funding and the continuation of such funding under a grant agreement is expressly dependent upon the availability to the Department of funds appropriated by the State or Federal legislature from State and/or Federal revenue to such other funding sources as may be applicable. A failure of the Department to make any payment under a grant agreement or to observe and perform any condition on its part to be performed under a grant agreement as a result of the failure of the State or Federal legislature to appropriate funds shall not in any manner constitute a breach of a grant agreement by the Department or an event of default under a grant agreement and the Department shall not be held liable for any breach of a grant agreement because of the absence of available funding

appropriations. In addition, future funding shall not be anticipated from the Department beyond the duration of the award period set forth in a grant agreement and in no event shall a grant agreement be construed as a commitment by the Department to expend funds beyond the termination date set in a grant agreement.
