NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

DUTIES: Under the limited supervision of a supervisory official within the Division of Law, Docketing Unit, performs docketing duties including opening, updating and closing cases using automated case tracking system; converts raw data from legal documents, case files and other source documents; compiles and prepares data for conversion into the current Division of Law Case Tracking System; processes information, compiling, coding, categorizing, calculating, tabulating, auditing, or verifying information or data; receives and responds to telephone inquiries and emails concerning specific data tracked; prepares online reports and runs data queries by determining search elements and provides technical assistance to deputies; acts as communication link and technical advisor between the Administration (support staff) and Section Supervisors in reporting data pertinent to the case management system; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS:

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with an Associate's degree..

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in providing support to functions such as grant/contract compliance monitoring, program monitoring, or fiscal compliance and budgetary assistance and/or providing technical assistance to state and/or local communities or agencies, completing forms or applications, reviewing documents for accuracy and content, resolving complaints, or interpreting rules, regulations, policies, and procedures for the public, and/or others.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required experience may substitute additional education as indicated on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>PREFERENCE</u>: Preference will be given to candidates who possess experience with ACMS and PACER judicial programs to perform research on the status of cases.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date.
