<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of a Deputy Attorney General 1 or 2, or other supervisory official in the Division of Criminal Justice, handles all aspects of appellate case litigation, including criminal appeals pending in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Appellate Division, the New Jersey Supreme Court, habeas litigation in the federal courts, as well as criminal cases of statewide significance in lower state and federal courts; researches legal issues; prepares legal memorandum; files, prepares and argues Orders to Show Cause in the Law Division; argues cases before the Appellate Division; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey is required.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

NOTE: Positions will be filled on a part-time, temporary basis. Candidates selected to fill vacancies will be limited to 944 hours of work in a fiscal year.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to candidates with at least 3 years of experience in criminal appellate practice.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date.
