A temporary employment services opportunity exists in the unclassified service with the Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Gaming Enforcement, for applicants who meet the requirements specified below:

<u>TITLE</u>: Special Services (Hourly Administrative Analyst)

SALARY: \$49.07 per hour

LOCATION: Division of Gaming Enforcement Administrative Services Bureau 140 E. Front Street Trenton, NJ

NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under general supervision of a supervisory official in the Division of Gaming Enforcement, reviews and processes fiscal and travel transactions in NJSTART/ MACSE/ NJCFS; performs complex analysis and audits; procures goods and services with minimal training; assists with the completion of forecasts and budget documents; performs internal audits to ensure fiscal compliance; maintains internal financial documents and records; does other related duties as required.

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>:

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree including or supplemented by twentyone (21) semester hour credits in any combination of Accounting, Business Administration, Economics or Finance courses. *Transcripts must be submitted to confirm credits earned*.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience in work involving fiscal analyses and evaluation, budgeting, and management operations in government, business, and/or a management consulting firm.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the Bachelor's degree, but who do possess the (21) semester hour credits as listed above, may substitute the remaining education with experience as indicated above on a year for year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree in one of the areas listed above may be substituted for one (1) year of experience; a Doctorate degree in one of the areas listed above may be substituted for two (2) years of experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants who have had previous state experience in fiscal and procurement including NJSTART, MACSE, NCFS and/or Business Objects. Knowledge of Excel.

<u>SPECIAL NOTE</u>: Positions will be filled on a part-time, temporary basis. Candidates selected to fill vacancies will be limited to 944 work hours in a fiscal year.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
