DUTIES: Under direction of the Executive Director, a State Investigator 1 or 2, or other supervisory official within the New Jersey Racing Commission ("NJRC"), the State Investigator 4 investigates and gathers information relevant to individuals and entities active in the New Jersey horse racing industry in order to determine compliance with the NJRC's rules. Conducts field investigations and interviews to obtain information and statements; gathers evidence, analyzes and records information; prepares narrative investigative reports; serves as liaison with federal, state and local government entities; organizes and maintains files and fingerprint records and performs routine inspections of off-track stabling facilities to determine suitability for initial and continued licensure pursuant to the NJRC's rules; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience conducting background or criminal type investigations including the review and analysis of financial and accounting records.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as required on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree or certification as a Certified Public Accountant may be substituted for one (1) year of the indicated experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will only be based upon information presented in resume. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating its U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
