<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the direction of the Executive Director the Board of Medical Examiners, oversees the Board's Medical Practitioner Review Panel and manages the operations of this unit that is responsible for reviewing and presenting medical malpractice cases for disciplinary assessment. Oversees the disciplinary filings and compliance with Board Orders. Conducts follow up on investigations, schedules meetings, conducts meetings, and drafts agendas and minutes of the Panel. Coordinates filings of Orders and follows up to ensure compliance with the Orders and reports to the National Practitioner Databank; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience in planning, monitoring, coordinating, implementing, modifying and/or evaluating agency programs and services; one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity over professional or technical staff.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree from an accredited college or university in a discipline appropriate to the position may be substituted for one (1) year of non-supervisory experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants with a JD; or a degree in medicine; or, a degree in nursing.
