<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the direction of a supervisory official in the Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, provides management support by developing and forming strategies, plans, policies and programmatic efforts aimed at improving work operations concerning the agencies statewide traffic safety initiatives; makes recommendations and assists with policy formulation as a trusted advisor to executives concerning traffic safety campaigns and in consultation with the Office of the Attorney General's Communication's office; evaluates the effectiveness of new strategies, plans, policies and programs by conducting surveys, receiving feedback, and leading focus groups; coordinates bid proposals and subsequent contracts/grants for the Division's public awareness campaigns; manages the Director's public speaking engagements; develops plans and strategies to implement new programs and initiatives, as well as lead or serve on special project committees; performs related activities that promote new programs and initiatives impacting the Division; coordinates daily work assignments of team members and provides staff leadership as needed to ensure that staff are prepared for assignments and that assignments are completed in a timely fashion; performs other related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in the planning and/or administration of highway safety or related programs.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

<u>LICENSE</u>: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
