<u>DUTIES</u>: Under supervision of the Deputy Director or other supervisory official in the Division of Consumer Affairs, performs legal research and prepares documents, reports, summaries and recommendations to be used by legal staff in judicial documents, legal papers, and attorney memoranda; performs other related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of paralegal or legal/legislative research experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year for year basis.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Bachelor's degree in Law may be substituted for both the education and experience requirements listed above.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess a Bachelor's degree may substitute an Associate's degree as a Legal Assistant or in Paralegal Studies or, successful completion of a two (2) year approved course in Paralegal Training at a recognized educational institution for two (2) years of college education.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is required to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>PREFERENCE</u>: Preference will be given to applicants with a Paralegal certificate or training; experience working in a legal setting for a government agency or private law firm.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will only be based upon information presented in resume. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating its U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date.
