DUTIES: Under the direction of an Administrative Analyst 4, Deputy Director of Grant or the Director of Grants will be responsible for overseeing the administration of Federal and State programs for the Department of Law and Public Safety. Performs the review and analysis of Federal and State grants awarded to the Department; assists with the execution of sub-grant contracts and the review of financial documentation to ensure allowable expenses while adhering to grant conditions, regulations and procedures for proper utilization of Federal and State resources; performs ongoing analysis for the appropriate distribution of grant funds to sub recipients; review programmatic reports to ensure goals and objectives are being met; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience involving the review, analysis, and evaluation of budget, organization, administrative practices, operation methods, management operations, or data processing applications, or any combination thereof, which shall have included responsibility for the recommendation, planning, and/or implementation of improvements in a business or government agency.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Public Administration, Business Administration, Economics, Finance, or Accounting may be substituted for one (1) year of indicated experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
