## **NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE:** One (1)

**<u>DUTIES</u>**: Under the general direction of the Executive Director and executive staff, plans, organizes and supervises staff engaged in the licensing of owners, trainers, stable employees, off-track stabling facilities and others who participate in horse racing in New Jersey. Supervises the receipt of revenue and responsible for ensuring revenues are properly accounted for. Supervises the issuance of official license identification cards and responsible for oversight of fingerprint submission, verification and renewal. Reviews race programs to ensure that all persons, horses and organizations are properly entered and duly licensed; performs other related work as assigned.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree.

**EXPERIENCE:** Five (5) years of experience as an inspector of personnel, horses and procedures at thoroughbred and harness racing tracks in New Jersey, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

**<u>NOTE</u>**: Applicants who do not possess a college degree may substitute additional non-supervisory experience as described above on a year for year basis.

**LICENSE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

**PREFERENCE:** Preference will be given to applicants with licensing experience in horse racing.

**<u>RESUME NOTE</u>**: Eligibility determinations will only be based upon information presented in resume. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating its U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
