<u>DUTIES</u>: Under limited supervision of the Information Technology Management & Support (ITMS) Application Development Unit Supervisor, performs analysis, maintenance, programming, and support work on modules of existing systems. Develop, create, and maintain PEGA applications developed for the Division's PEGA application system. Candidate will be accountable for complex programming / coding on the Pega platorm; does other related duties.

Candidate should be proficient in Pega Implementation life cycle like modeling of business process, PRPC tool installation, development, testing, deployment. Familiarity with Scrum and Agile methodology. Pega certification is preferred.
