<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the supervision of a food service supervisor or other supervisory officer, prepares and cooks food in large quantities; may take the lead in a group of food service workers or residents engaged in preparing, cooking, serving, and storing food; involved in the transport of prepared meals; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience as a cook involving the preparation of a variety of food in large quantities.

NOTE: Catering experience in a delicatessen will be acceptable.

NOTE: Deli counter experience in a delicatessen will NOT be acceptable.

NOTE: Cooking experience in a fast food establishment will NOT be acceptable.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

SPECIAL NOTE: Appointment to this title may be made provisionally, pending the outcome of an open-competitive examination (PAOC). If selected for the position and appointed PAOC, you will be required to apply for the open-competitive examination, when issued by the Civil Service Commission for this title, pass and be reachable on the resulting eligible list to become permanent in the position. Appointees who fail to be reachable on the resulting CSC eligible list are subject to removal.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determination will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
