<u>**DUTIES:**</u> Under general supervision in the Juvenile Justice Commission, is responsible for analyzing procurement transactions, proposals, goods, commodities or services, in order to ensure efficient and effective procurement; Supervises staff and work activities. Prepares and signs official performance evaluations for subordinate staff; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience in the procurement/purchasing process through the competitive bidding process for a large public or private organization.
