<u>DUTIES</u>: Under supervision of the Director, Division of Consumer Affairs (Division), Department of Law & Public Safety, performs confidential legislative, legal, and policy influencing research related to Division programs, pending and existing legislation, in conformance with guidelines established by the Attorney General formulating and transmitting requests for legal advice on behalf of the Division and its professional licensing boards, regulated business sections, and consumer protection units; prepares reports and recommendations on the impact of proposed or existing legislation; does related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with Juris Doctor (J.D.) or a Bachelor of Laws (L.L.B.) degree.

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience involving legal or legislative research, drafting of rules, regulations, legislation, amendments, and/or the interpretation of statutes.

NOTE: Appointees currently matriculating in an accredited law school as an LL.B or J.D. candidate may substitute such enrollment for the three (3) years of required experience on a year-for-year basis.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is required to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants with supervisory experience in the provision of legal, legislative or regulatory services in a government agency.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will only be based upon information presented in resume. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating its U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date.
