**<u>DUTIES</u>**: Under the close supervision of a supervisory official in the Division of Consumer Affairs, as a trainee and productive worker provides basic and/or repetitive front-line and behind the scenes customer and other support services involving the review, processing and issuance of agency documents; provides information to customers regarding department/agency programs and services; does other related work as required.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

**LICENSE:** Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position

**<u>PROMOTION</u>**: Applicants who successfully complete the six (6) month training period will be eligible for promotion to the title of Agency Services Representative 1 in accordance with Civil Service Commission procedures. *The inability of an employee in a trainee title to successfully attain a level of performance warranting advancement shall be considered cause for separation.* 

**<u>RESUME NOTE</u>**: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
