NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under supervision of the Director or other supervisory official in the Office of the Director, Division of Consumer Affairs, is responsible for research and analysis of information, consulting with stakeholders, government officials and internal staff, and the development of options and preparation of recommendations on a wide range of policy projects. Responsibilities will include the coordination and implementation of operational policies, programs and strategies necessary to support the Division's overall plans and objectives; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with Juris Doctor (J.D.) or a Bachelor of Law (L.L.B) degree.

(OR)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience involving legal or legislative research, drafting of rules, regulations, legislation, amendments, and/or the interpretation of statutes.

NOTE: Appointee currently matriculating in an accredited law school as an L.L.B. or JD candidate may substitute such enrollment for the three (3) years of required experience on a year-for-year basis.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants who possess a Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree and three (3) years of experience in legal or legislative research, drafting of rules, regulations, legislation, amendments, and/or the interpretation of statutes; or to applicants with legal, legislative or regulatory experience in complex consumer policy matters.

Appointees will be required to be compliant with all Executive Orders (EO), mandates, policies, and directives related to Covid-19, including testing and vaccinations, and including but not limited to EO 252 (Murphy), EO 283 (Murphy) and/or EO 290 (Murphy).
