DUTIES: Under the direction of the Director or other supervisory official in the Division of Consumer Affairs (DCA), responsible for providing assistance in analyzing and implementing legislative and regulatory initiatives related to the Prescription Monitoring Program, CDS laws and other opioid and healthcare issues; will also assist in implementing administrative and regulatory policy initiatives impacting DCA's professional licensing boards; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with Juris Doctor (J.D.) or a Bachelor of Law (L.L.B) degree.
(OR)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience involving legal or legislative research, drafting of rules, regulations, legislation, amendments, and/or the interpretation of statutes.

NOTE: Appointee currently matriculating in an accredited law school as an L.L.B. or JD candidate may substitute such enrollment for the three (3) years of required experience on a year-for-year basis.

NOTE: The legal specialist may be a fulltime law school student working for the State on a limited part-time basis or during periods when law school is not in session.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.esx

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants who possess a Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree and experience working with the Division of Consumer Affairs' professional boards and committees.

SPECIAL NOTE: Special Services positions are filled on a part-time, temporary basis, during normal business hours, and limited to 944 work hours in a fiscal year.

Appointees will be required to be compliant with all Executive Orders (EO), mandates, policies, and directives related to Covid-19, including testing and vaccinations, and including but not limited to EO 252 (Murphy), EO 283 (Murphy) and/or EO 290 (Murphy).
