DUTIES: Under direction of a Head Grounds Worker or other supervisory official in the Juvenile Justice Commission, does tasks involved in the maintenance of grounds; perform other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS:

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience in the performance of semiskilled grounds keeping work.

LICENSE: Appointee may be required to obtain a New Jersey Certified Pesticide Applicator's or Operator's Permit in the required categories.
