<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the direction of a supervisory officer in the Facilities and Support Services Unit, Juvenile Justice Commission, will be responsible for coordinating and working with contracted consultants and contractors on constructions projects; attends meetings involving construction projects and capital improvement programs; conducts inspections of ongoing construction projects ensuring compliance with current building codes; oversees design and construction process ensuring completion and adherence to schedules, budget and requirements; develops scopes of work for specific construction or improvement projects; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in the field of architecture, engineering, project management, construction contract management, financial contract management, facilities management, construction quality assurance, or related area involving complex building projects.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree in a specialty area related to construction may be substituted for one (1) year of required experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: Possession of a valid Architect's License issued by the Board of Architects and Certified Landscape Architects may be substituted for two (2) years of required experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: Possession of a valid Professional Engineer's License issued by the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors may be substituted for two (2) years of required experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: Possession of a valid New Jersey Uniform Construction Code License issued by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs may be substituted for one (1) year of required experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only.
