<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of a supervisory official in the Juvenile Justice Commission, takes a leading part in the mechanical maintenance, adjustment, and repair of heating, air conditioning, and refrigerating systems, and auxiliary equipment and may operate these systems as required; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in work involving the installation, inspection, repair, maintenance, and operation of heating, air conditioning, and refrigeration systems, machinery, diesel generators, and auxiliary equipment including welding, piping, and insulations.

LICENSE: Applicants will be required to possess a valid Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Technician Certification of the appropriate level, commensurate with the type of equipment serviced, issued under the authority of the Federal Environmental Protection Agency.

Appointees may be required to possess a Boiler Operator's License (Black Seal) of appropriate grade and type as issued by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development. The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the appropriate grade and type of license, rests with the Appointing Authority.

Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

Appointees will be required to be compliant with all Executive Orders (EO), mandates, and directives related to Covid-19 vaccinations, including but not limited to EO 252, EO 283 and/or EO290.
